## Worcestershire Junior Squash County League Rules For Under 17s (Boys & Girls) 2004/05

- 1. All teams to consist of five players, who will play in order of merit. In the event of a player being unable to compete, all players move up and the game at five is conceded.
- 2. Teams can be mixed or single sex. Must be 17 or under by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2004.
- 3. A ranking list must be supplied with date of birth before the start of the season. Players must not change order of position in a team unless the league organiser is notified. (Please rank boys and girls together in merit order).
- All clubs wishing to submit teams to the league must supply the League Organiser with a £5.00 entry fee per team by 1<sup>st</sup> October. (Cheques made payable to: Worcestershire S.R.A.).
- 5. All matches shall be the best of 5 games. American scoring shall be used, ie. point per rally. At 14 all setting will be used to 17 points in all games including the 5<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. A player shall receive 1 point for each game won, and the winning team shall receive 4 points for the match win.
- 7. It is the Home side who needs to fill in a league card and send to the organiser within 7 days of a match played.
- 8. The host club shall be appointed by the league, and shall be responsible for the booking of courts, and the cost of both courts and balls.
- 9. The home team is responsible for providing refreshments after the match (e.g. Sandwiches, cake, biscuits, crisps and a cold drink).
- 10. All matches to be played on either Saturday or Sunday at the discretion of the home team. Teams to play each other twice (home and away) between October and March.
- 11. Dates of matches to be sent out to clubs before the start of the season. Matches can only be altered due to bad weather or if both clubs mutually agree.
- 12. All players are now advised (not mandatory) to wear suitable eye protection, as advised by the England Squash.
- 13. In the event of any dispute the Organisers' decision is final.
